



Gubi Silk Lantern Wall Light

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PRODUCT DESCRIPTION

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Gubi Silk Lantern Wall Light is based on a 1951 design by Ejner Larsen and Aksel Bender Madsen. The Silk Lantern was first shown at the Cabinetmakers' Guild Exhibition, but was not put into production at the time. Its cylindrical form takes cues from traditional Japanese lanterns, while the construction and material choices place it within Danish modern design.

Natural silk is used for the shade, with walnut veneer rings at the top and bottom. The frame is lacquered steel in Soft Black. When switched on, the silk diffuses the light across the shade, leaving some areas brighter than others.

The Silk Lantern Wall Light is non-dimmable and operated by an in-line switch on its 250cm cable. The adjustable shade height brings subtle flexibility to the design, while the Silk Lantern family can be used individually or repeated to build a harmonious rhythm across a space. Best suited to soft atmospheric accent lighting, either as a single wall light or in repeated arrangements.

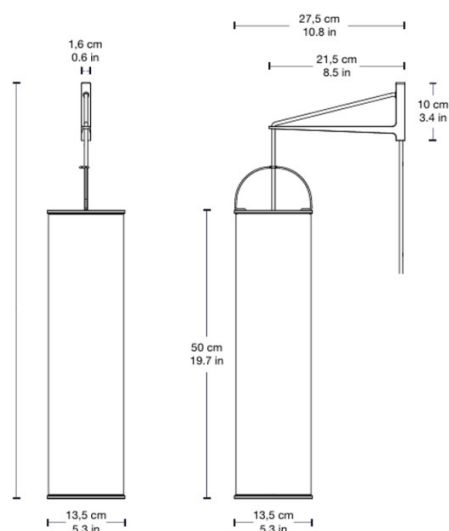
