PRODUCT DESCRIPTION

Gubi Silk Lantern Pendant Light

Gubi Silk Lantern Pendant comes from a 1951 design by Ejner Larsen and Aksel Bender Madsen. It was shown at the Cabinetmakers' Guild Exhibition that year, but was not put into production. The cylindrical shade takes its cue from traditional Japanese lanterns, while the construction reflects the principles of Danish modern design.

The cylindrical shade is formed from natural silk, with two walnut veneer rings framing the textile from above and below. As the lamp is illuminated, the silk gently diffuses the light across its surface to create an intimate gradient of brightness and shadow, while the lacquered steel structure adds definition and architectural restraint to the almost-floating shade.

The Silk Lantern Pendant can be dimmed with a suitable dimmable bulb and is suspended from a soft-black ceiling canopy. Used individually, the pendant creates a soft atmospheric accent, while repeated installations can establish a harmonious rhythm across an interior. Best suited to dining areas and other interior spaces where soft, atmospheric light is required.

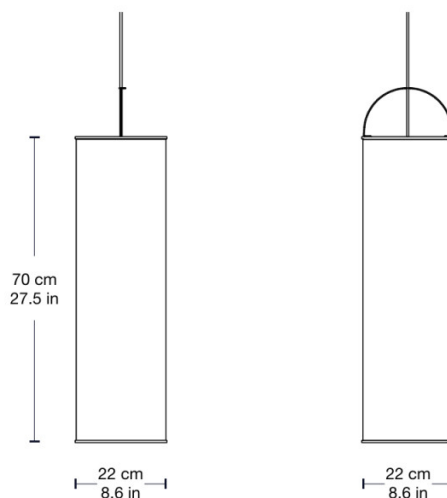
