## &Tradition Flowerpot VP3 Table Lamp

Designed by the legendary Verner Panton, the Flowerpot VP3 was the first of two <u>table lamp</u> variants to be introduced to the Flowerpot range in 1969. His inspiration came from the Flower Power movement which took the 1960's by storm, resulting in Panton creating a fun and colourful lighting solution that creates a cosy atmosphere for your interior.



Where the original Flowerpot <u>pendants</u> consist simply of two metal hemispheres, one twice the size of the other, which serve as diffusers for a concealed light source, the Flowerpot VP3 adds a third, the same size as the smaller hemisphere but inverted to be used as a base. This allows it to stand freely on a desk or coffee table, to be used as a task light or simply to create an intimate atmosphere in a reading nook or bedroom. The Flowerpot collection also includes three pendants – the <u>VP1</u>, <u>VP2</u> , and VP7 – and another, more distinct table lamp, the VP4.
