Le Klint 224 Wall Light

The 224 Wall Light, also known as the “Sax Light”, was designed by Erik Hansen in 1952. Erik Hansen first contacted Le Klint when he was looking for a shade for a light that he had made. Le Klint took an interest in his design, which led to Hansen developing the idea further for the lighting brand. The resulting product was the 224 Sax Light, which to this day is one of Le Klint's most popular models. The 224 Wall Light features an accordion-like frame that can be extended depending on where you require the light. This wooden bracket is equipped with a textile rope

The Le Klint 224 is available in a light oak finish with a textile rope weaving through the frame. The pleated shade is synonymous with Le Klint and gives the lamp its classic aesthetic. Available in a plastic or paper finish, the shade diffuses light into a gentle glow that is warm and functional. While similar in colour, the plastic foil shade has fire-retardant and UV-resistant properties. The paper shade will patinate and develop a golden hue over time. This classic wall light is an elegant lighting solution next to a bedside or in a reading nook. It is suitable for both domestic and commercial spaces where a welcoming atmosphere is required.
