325 Floor Lamp by Le Klint

This classic design was first developed in 1957 by Vilhelm Wohlert in connection with the refurbishment of the famous Danish physicist Niels Bohr. With a wooden stand and a plastic foil or paper shade, the 325 floor lamp has a hand-crafted feel whilst boasting elegant lines and design.

The transversal arm can be angled and is also able to move up and down on the stand. The lamp head can also be tilted, making this floor light very functional. With a directional light this floor lamp is perfect to use as a reading light for lounge areas in both home and work spaces. To create a seamless design scheme, pair with the [Le Klint 224 wall light](#) which also combines a delicate folded lampshade with a wooden frame to produce a truly timeless piece.
