PRODUCT DESCRIPTION

Doo-Wop Pendant Light by Louis Poulsen

The Doo-Wop pendant was first made in the 1950s by Louis Poulsen in collaboration with the Danish Navy Buildings Department. The pendant was used throughout many Navy buildings, including offices and canteens, and was originally named the Navy pendant because of this. It was used because of the upward and downward directed light that is created by the beautiful curved shade which resembles the "New Look" silhouette seen in 1950s fashion.

After being taken out the Louis Poulsen brand in the 1980s, the Doo-Wop pendant light was reintroduced in 2012 with its brand new name, becoming an instant timeless classic that is still relevant today. The pendant light has a subtle white centre with the choice of 5 finishes for the hourglass lampshade to find the right match for your design scheme. Stylish and iconic, this light can be used in many different settings either alone, in rows or a cluster to create the illumination you need to create a warm and inviting atmosphere.

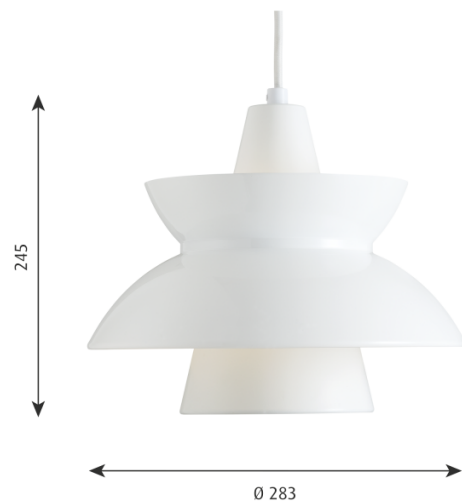
