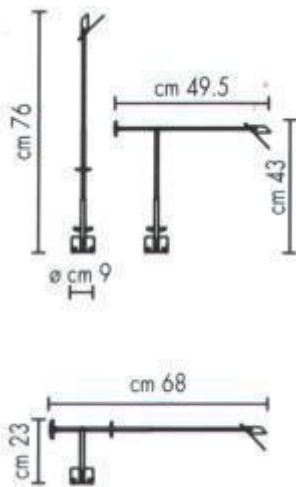
Artemide Tizio Micro Table Lamp
