## Luceplan Lola Wall Light

The Luceplan Lola Wall Light, designed by Alberto Meda and Paolo Rizzatto, is a lightweight lamp whose design was based upon the theme of dematerialisation in the world of lighting - resulting in the stripped back and minimalistic style of this light. Lola is easily recognisable with a light head made of glass fibre reinforced polyester, the head also hosts a micro perforated steel reflector that shields the light source, the reflector can be orientated by a thin rod to provide either a direct or indirect light. The elegant lines and minimalistic triangular shape turn Lola into a stylish light, it is both bold yet discreet.

Alberto Meda and Paolo Rizzatto have created a timeless light fixture with an beautifully simple shape using complex technologies - the Lola Wall Light is the carbon fibre lamp whose technology, form and highly innovative qualities earned it the Compasso d'Oro prize.

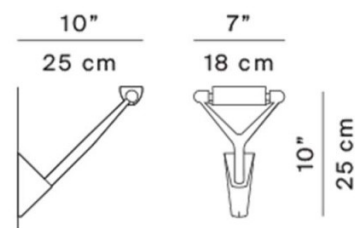
